# Curriculum

Reading: As readers, students will explore cause and effect relationships in nonfiction text, specifically biographies.

**Writing:** As writers, students will continue developing skills for writing in paragraphs that include a topic sentence, supporting details, and textual evidence.

Math: As mathematicians, students will investigate and solve multi-step word problems. Students will participate in think alouds and mini-lessons that focus on the organization and steps that go into solving a variety of multi-step word problems.

Science: As scientists, students will study 6 animal classifications and the characteristics of each of these groups. Students will also compare and contrast the life cycles of each of these animal groups.
