Curriculum

Reading: As readers, students will discuss how text features help readers determine the most important ideas in a nonfiction text.

Writing: As writers, students will begin crafting parts of an imagined narrative, particularly developing a believable character by using various character traits and motivations.

Math: As mathematicians, students will continue their exploration of multiplication concepts using arrays and number lines. Students will use these strategies while working with word problems, too.

Social Studies: As scientists, students will continue their exploration of plants by reading a variety of texts, both in print and digitally. They will take a closer look at the characteristics of living, non-living and once-living objects. Each child will set up an experiment to explore the needs of all plants using the Scientific Method.
