Curriculum

Reading: As readers, students will discuss how text features help readers determine the most important ideas (main idea) in a nonfiction text and how they use details from the text to support their thinking.

Writing: As writers, students will learn how to develop their narrative by showing, not telling, using descriptive language and dialogue among characters.

Math: As mathematicians, students will begin an exploration of division concepts and continue determining the most important information in word problems by using key math words.

Science: As scientists, our class will utilize the Scientific Method to further explore burning questions about plants.
