Curriculum

Reading: As readers, students will use their ability to determine the main idea of a text to compare and contrast the main idea of two texts.

Writing: As writers, students will learn how to develop their narrative by showing, not telling, using descriptive language and dialogue among characters. Students will also look for a way to provide closure in their narrative.

Math: As mathematicians, students will continue exploring division concepts and continue determining the most important information in word problems by using key math words. Students will also practice using a variety of division strategies.

Science: As scientists, our class will utilize the Scientific Method to further explore burning questions about plants.
