CURRICULUM

Reading: As readers, students will be using a variety of resources to help them solve for unknown words (dictionary, thesaurus, context clues)

Writing: As writers, students will be analyzing words found in historical documents. We will also continue our paragraph writing from unit 4.

Math: As mathematicians, students will be exploring and measuring polygons in order to calculate the perimeter and area of the shapes in order to make real-world decisions.

Social Studies: As historians, students will explore the concept of patriotism and how this is important to American culture.
