Curriculum

Reading: As readers, students will be continue learning about the following text structures: chronological order, cause and effect, and comparison writing.

Writing: As writers, students will be conducting a small research project on the many reasons people came to America. Students will turn their research into a written presentation.

Math: As mathematicians, students will solve real-world problems using area and perimeter concepts.

Social Studies: As historians, students will explore the five themes of geography, focusing on different types of maps and settlement patterns. Students will also learn about patriotism.
