Curriculum

Reading: As readers, students will explore a narrator's view point and compare it with their own view point.

Writing: As writers, students will revise, edit and publish their opinion pieces.

Math: As mathematicians, students will explore various graphing concepts. They will also practice finding the most accurate measurements using a ruler, by rounding to the nearest $\frac{1}{2}$ inch or nearest $\frac{1}{4}$ inch, making connections to fractions.

Science: As scientists, students will begin to investigate various weather concepts and tools that can be used to measure weather.

READING:
