# Curriculum

Reading & Writing: As readers, students will practice summarizing and practice their fluency reading <u>My Father's</u> <u>Dragon</u>. They will work collaboratively with a small group to read, write, illustrate and publish a summary of a selected chapter in the book.

Math: As mathematicians, students will explore various measurement concepts with volume (milliliters, liters) and mass (grams/ kilograms).

Science: As scientists, students will begin to investigate various weather concepts and tools that can be used to measure weather.
