Curriculum

Reading: As readers, students will dig deeper into understanding characters in the text they are reading by describing them using various character traits and evidence read in the text.

Writing: As writers, students will begin exploring parts of speech (nouns, pronouns and verbs) and how to use these to express themselves in writing.

Math: As mathematicians, students will continue exploring rounding and estimation concepts. This will be a link to questioning whether their computation for adding or subtracting is reasonable.

Social Studies: As historians, students will discuss types of interactions among people.
